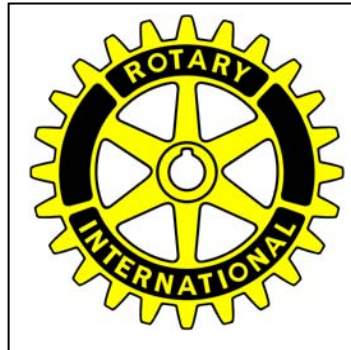

During his career, Lt Col Lawrence has been on 110 combat sorties and flown for over 5,000 hours.
